



## MEMBERS & VISITORS' DRESS CODE

### ON THE COURSE

We do accept that fashion changes quickly and our policy is that any smart, recognised golf clothing is permissible. Tailored shorts may be worn with any variety of sports socks.

#### MENS GOLF SHIRTS

Mens' golf shirts must have collars, sleeves and be tucked into trousers.

#### NOT PERMITTED

Athletic, football, numbered style shirts or tracksuits.  
i.e. clothing not associated with golf attire.

#### GOLF SHOES

All golfers must wear golf shoes when playing practicing and on the putting green. Golf shoes with either soft spikes or dimples should be worn.

### IN THE CLUBHOUSE

Any smart casual clothing is acceptable, but we ask that waterproofs and headwear be removed when inside the clubhouse.

Smart, clean denims are fine in and around the clubhouse but overly casual football shorts, tops, flip flops and similar will be discouraged

Dirty and muddy or wet clothing/footwear must be avoided if at all possible

### MOBILE PHONES

Mobile phones inside the clubhouse are requested to be on silent.

Calls should be taken in the locker room or outside where possible to give consideration to others using the clubhouse.

The Clubhouse rules may understandably be relaxed for functions and for children. The overriding moral is to be considerate of others.

Members are responsible for themselves and their guests re: dress and behaviour. Complaints should be made to Council who have the right to take action.
