1. OUT OF BOUNDS

a) In the clubhouse

- b) Beyond the boundaries of the course, as defined by the stone wall to the right of the 2nd/11th and 4th/13th holes. (including the fence alongside. c) Any part of the car park. The wall to the right of the 1st tee and the fence alongside the
- car park are course boundaries, as is the fence behind the 9th/18th green alongside the car park at the rear of the clubhouse.
- d) To the left of the white posts on the 1st/10th holes (including the plantation to the left of
- the 1st /10th green)
 e) To the right of the white posts on the 6th/15th holes.
- f) To the left of the white posts on the 8th/17th holes. g) To the right of the boundary fence of the 9th\/18th holes.

- 2. ROADS AND PATHS.

All roads and paths on the course even if not artificially surfaced are to be treated as immovable obstructions from which relief without penalty is allowed under rule 16-1.

3. PENALTY AREAS

 a) All open drains on the course are penalty areas under rule 17-1.
 b) Behind the 8th/17th green or adjacent to it when playing the 9th/18th as defined by the red stakes and or line on the ground. If a ball is in the defined penalty area behind / adjacent to the 8th/17th green, including when

it is known or virtually certain that a lost ball came to rest in the penalty area, the player has these relief options. Take relief under Rule 17.1, play the ball as it lies, or for a one shot penalty, drop the ball or another ball in case of ball deemed lost in penalty area in the dropping zone adjacent to the 8th/17th green when playing the 8th/17th, or adjacent to the road when playing the 9th/18th hole. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14-3.

Penalty for playing ball from wrong place in breach of Local Rule : General Penalty 14-7a.

4. NO PLAY ZONES a) Within the wires protecting any green not being played, with the exception of the 1st /10th when playing the 2nd/11th holes. A ball lying within the protected area around the

- 1st/10th green when playing the 2nd/11th holes, must be played as it lies, unless the ball is on the green where relief must be taken under Rule 13.1f.
- b) The practice putting green and its adjacent garden areas.
 c) Fenced tree plantations (except at the back of the 1st/10th green)
 d) Staked, Newly Planted or protected trees if they interfere with a players stance or intended swing, are classified as no play zones and relief must be taken without penalty, except when the ball is in a penalty area. When a player's ball is in a penalty area, there is no

relief and the player's only option is to take penalty relief under Rule 17.

Relief without penalty MUST be taken from a No Play Zone (rule 2.4), with the exception of Penalty Areas, under Rule 16.1f. A ball must be dropped in accordance with rule 14.3. A ball not found in a tree plantation, including when it is known or virtually certain that a lost ball came to rest in the plantation must be dropped without penalty as the estimated point of entry of the plantation not nearer the hole.

5. WIRES AND POSTS

- a) All wires and post protecting the greens and plantations, are to be treated as immovable obstructions under rule 16.1.
 b) Any shot that is seen to hit the wires or posts immediately protecting any green must
- be retaken without penalty from where the last shot was played from. With the exception of tee shots on the 7th / 16th hitting wires surrounding the 6th / 15th green, the ball must be played as lies.
- c) The fences and posts adjacent to the roads intersecting the 1st/10th, 8th/17th and 9th/18th holes are immovable obstructions, under rule 16.1.
- All hall which is known to have hit the fence and/or posts intersecting the 8th/17th fairway may be immediately replayed without penalty from where the last shot was played from.

 e) A ball hitting the fence adjacent to the roads intersecting the 1st/10th and 9th/18th holes
- must be played as lies. Relief for hitting the fence is not permitted. (Relief may still be taken under local rule 5c). f) Overhead power cables 7th/16th. A ball seen striking the cables must be replayed, without penalty

6. ABNORMAL GROUND CONDITIONS

- a) On closely mown areas only, protruding rocks may be treated as immovable obstructions and the ball can be lifted and dropped without penalty in accordance with Rule 16.1.
 b) Through the green relief may be taken without penalty for a ball lying in a distinct hoof
- mark. or tyre mark, and a ball lifted and dropped in accordance with Rule 16.1.
 c) Through the green, animal dung is a loose impediment, but if it cannot be easily removed
- and is interfering with the players stance or intended swing, or if the dung is in contact with the face of the ball. it may be regarded as an immovable obstruction and relief taken in accordance with Rule
- d) Relief may be taken from sunken drains crossing the 7th/16th and 8th/17th fairways without penalty Rule 16.1
